Stock Amateur Race Rules:

All Stock Mowers will go thru a thorough Technical Pre-Race Inspection.

Mowers must be of mass produced design and sold commercially thru a dealer to mow residential lawns. Mowers must remain suitable for lawn cutting.

Brakes must be functional. Seat Kill Switch Must be Functional.

BLADES MUST BE REMOVED.

Governed Engine maximum RPM is 3650. This will be checked.

Deck must be in the highest position with a minimum of 2.5" ground clearance.

NO Modifications are allowed to drive train (Changing pulleys). This will be checked.

Driver Racing Apparel Requirements:

Drivers must wear an Approved Helmet. Goggles or Face shield required for eye protection.

Glasses or Sunglasses are not permissible by themselves.

Every driver must wear long pants and long sleeve shirt.

Full Fingered gloves must be worn.

Over Ankle Footwear/Boots must be worn.

Awards to be determined.



A \$10.00 "One Day Pass" Fee is required for insurance.
